It has been a long year since NorCal JCL last came together, and we are looking forward to seeing everyone. Our theme for this Ludi is “*Separatim sed Una*” (Apart but Together), reminding attendees that while they may be joining us from their own computers in their own homes, they still belong to the welcoming, vibrant community that is the CAJCL! To foster this connection, we have been planning fun activities and contests for delegates to participate in via Zoom. We will have many of the classic events, including academic testing, certamen, colloquia, impromptu art, and a community service project, as well as some new, exciting virtual activities. Just like any other Ludi, JCLers will get to meet new friends, learn more about Latin and the classics, and make plenty of fun memories. Can’t wait!

Included in this packet are the event registration instructions, information about Sched (the event schedule website where Zoom links for events at Ludi will be located), flyer (to be shared with students), tentative schedule, activity descriptions, student waiver, and adult waiver. Once your school registers through the database, you will receive an email with your school’s registration spreadsheet and more information about participating in events at Ludi.

General Information:

When: 9:00 am - 5:00 pm

Where: Zoom (links will be on Sched.com)

Registration Cost: \$10 per student

Registration Deadline: November 1st

Tests: Tests will be taken on Google Forms. All students must take one test, but may take up to three. The testing subjects are: Ancient Geography, Classical Art, Daily Life, Derivatives, Grammar, Mottoes, Quotes, and Abbreviations, Mythology, Pentathlon, Roman History, Reading Comprehension, and Vocabulary.

Workshops: All delegates are required to attend two workshop sessions on Zoom.

Certamen: Certamen this year will be played on Zoom. Teams will be composed of students from the same schools. Levels will include Beginning (MS 1 & 2, HS 1), Intermediate (MS 3, HS 2) and Advanced (HS 3+). There will be two rounds of 15 questions and 2 related bonuses each.

Community Service: JCLers will be writing letters of appreciation to people who have impacted their lives positively, such as a coach, teacher, or friend.

Impromptu Art: Delegates will be encouraged to express their creativity by putting together a classically-themed art piece with the materials they have at home.

Et Cetera: Delegates will have all kinds of virtual games and events to choose from, including this year’s STEM challenge, Roman Rap Battle, Escape Rooms, Scavenger Hunt, and more!
