

# Code of Conduct

All attendees, speakers, sponsors and volunteers at the Southern California Regional Amici Madness conference (hereby referred to as SCRAM) are required to agree with the following code of conduct. ## At the event, you agree to...

- Respect confidentiality requests by other attendees.

## The following behaviors are not acceptable...

- Invasion of privacy, including taking photos, taking screenshots of conversations, or posting personal details about someone else without their permission.
- Being disruptive, stalking, following, or threatening anyone against their wishes.
- Abuse of power (including abuses related to position, wealth, race or gender).
- Homophobia, racism or behavior that discriminates against a group or class of people.
- Sexual harassment of any kind, including unwelcome sexual attention and inappropriate behavior.

## In the event of an incident...

If, while attending SCRAM, you (or someone you know) have been involved in or have witnessed an incident that violates this Code of Conduct, please use our name-optional reporting form to let our organizers know immediately. Share as much information as you can to help us make a thorough investigation.
